

6th Grade Distinguished Cub Award

In order to earn the Distinguished Cub Award the student must complete all 3 of the required items, the required 6th grade item and their choice of 12 optional items for a total of 16 out of 20 total items. If a student does not understand what is required on any item, it is their responsibility to request additional information from their teacher.

Required (School):

1. Have 10 or fewer absences and 5 or fewer tardies (excused and not excused.) Including ½ days, checkouts, vacations, etc.
2. No NI grades in the “Social Skills” portion of your report card for term 3.
3. Read at least 150 minutes per week outside of class most weeks.

Required (6th Grade):

4. Complete all aspects of the 6th grade country report

Optional (6th grade):

5. Science-create a science experiment related to a 6th grade science topic. Write a 1-page report discussing your findings.
6. Science-fully participate in the school science fair
7. Reading level-Reach a reading Lexile level of 1050 OR improve your Lexile level by at least 100 points.
8. Community Service-Plan and carry out a community service project of a minimum of 25 hours outside of school (and your home) and turn in a log of hours signed by a parent/guardian. **Due March 31st.**
9. Keyboarding-type a minimum of 30 words per minute on a timed test.
10. Creative arts-Participate in the PTA reflections program.
11. Geography-Complete 5 of the 7 geography maps. **Due Feb 1.**
12. Social Studies-Identify and provide a solution for a current social issue (multimedia) ex. Powerpoint, written report including graphics, pictures, etc. **Due March 31.**
13. Create a math picture book according to the directions provided. **Due 3/1**
14. Physical fitness-earn the physical fitness award.
15. School Service-Participate in safety patrol or student council until the end of the year.
16. Extra curricular-participate in a sports team, dance, music lessons etc. (Approve with teacher.)
17. Write a narrative book including pictures, plot, character, setting. 12-20 pages long. **Due February 10.**
18. Have an A or B in math for both of the first two terms.
19. Have an A or B in language arts for both of the first two terms.
20. Have an A or B in science for both of the first two terms.
