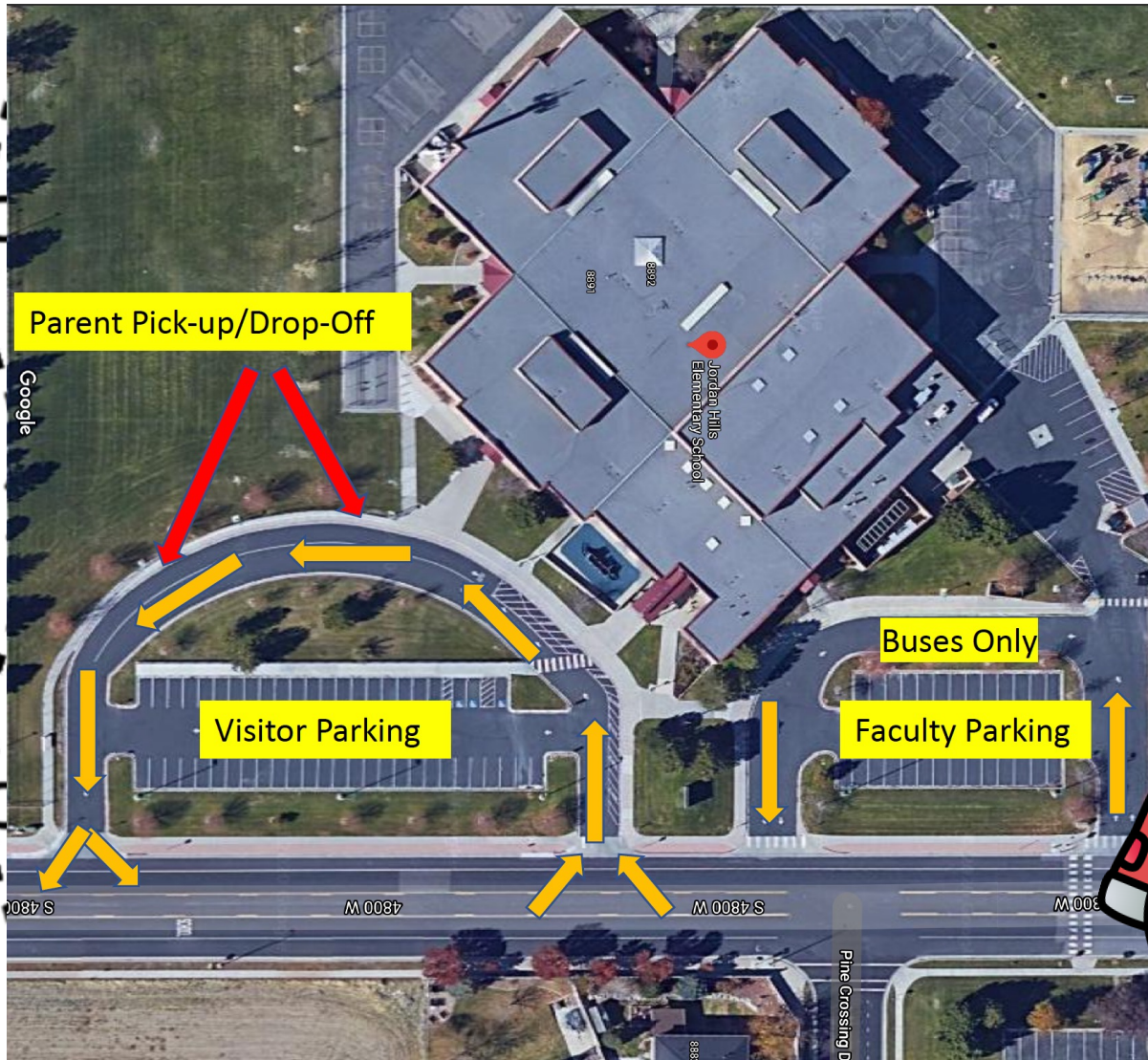


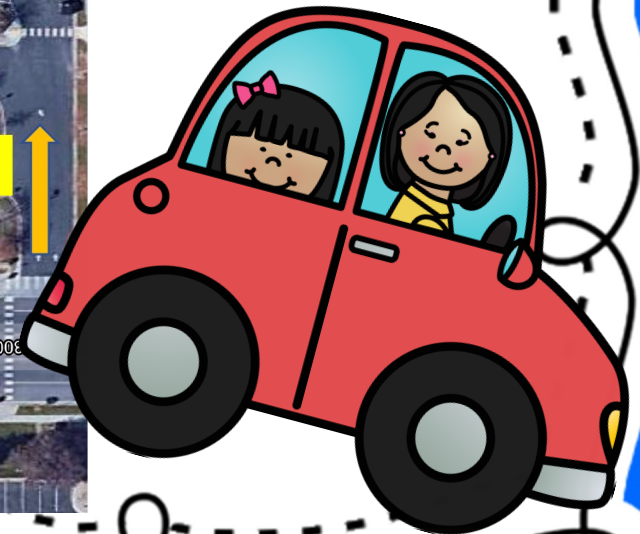

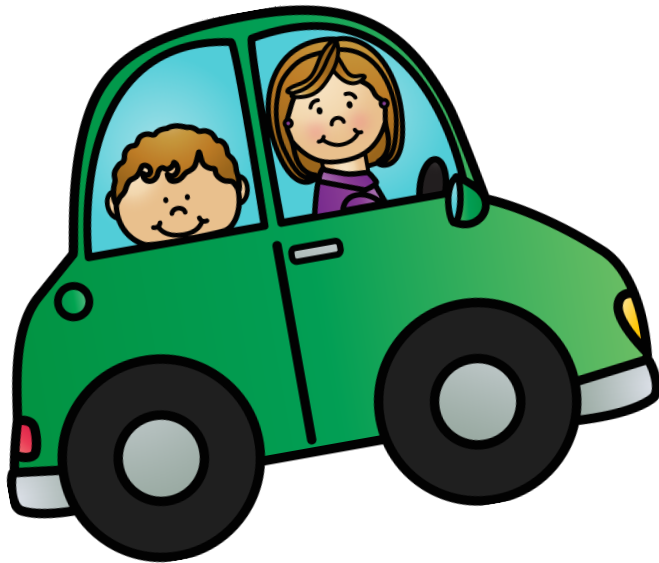

Pick-Up and Drop-Off Expectations

- Be kind and courteous to students, staff and other parents
- Alternate northbound and southbound traffic off of 4800 West entering the drop off zone. (Every other vehicle)
- The pull thru lane by the crosswalk has been blocked off. Please use the right lane to pull forward to the 'STOP' sign on the fence. After students have safely exited the car, signal and merge into the left lane (pull thru lane). This has proven the safest and most efficient process.
- **Pull as far forward, in the drop off lane, as possible** (To the fence 'STOP' sign)
- Have students ready to leave the car safely and quickly
- Never let students out of the car in the left hand "pull thru" lane
- Let students out on the passenger side of the car only
- Stay off cell phones while operating your vehicle
- Drop students off **after** the crosswalk from the parking lot
- Park in the parking lot if you need get out of your vehicle to help your student
- Students must be escorted by an adult in the parking lot
- Please do not leave your vehicle in the pick-up/drop-off lane.
- Please **do not** drop off students in the faculty parking lot or by the cafeteria.

We will have a safer, smoother Pick-Up and Drop-Off zone for Jordan Hills as we follow these procedures. We appreciate your support in helping to keep students safe at our school. Please call the office with any questions or concerns.

Supplies Needed:

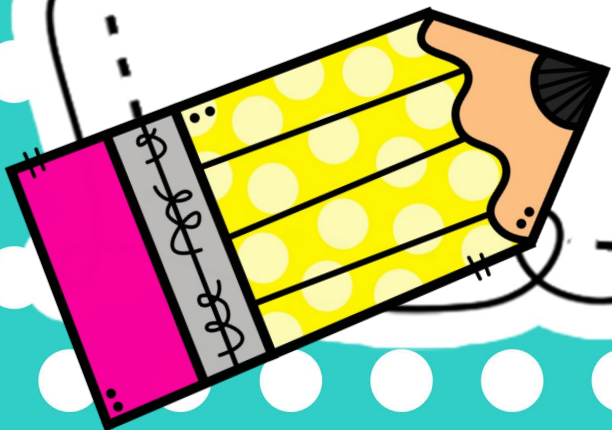
- *Backpack large enough to fit a folder

It is important that a positive balance be maintained in your student's lunch account.

Activities:

- Watch the Leap Frog Video Letter Factory
- Make letter sounds and ask your children to draw the matching letters in shaving cream or sand.
- Write letters on pieces of paper and put them in a paper bag. Let your child reach into the bag and take out letters. Have them say the letter name and the sound that matches the letter.
- Look for specific letters while reading to your child or driving in the car.
- Make letters out of playdough.
- Have students write the letters while watching an alphabet video.

Goal:

For students to recognize all upper and lowercase letters and their sounds by November 1st.
